Parent/Family Orientation Checklist

- Arrive On Campus (501 E. Saint Joseph Street)**
Park wherever it's most convenient for you. NO parking passes are required for the weekend.

- Go to your student's assigned residence hall to check in.**
Student helpers will be available to help with move-in. Residence hall assignments and instructions were emailed to each student's Mines email. If unsure of residence hall, go to the Surbeck Center front desk.
** If your student will be living off-campus, go to the next step.*

- Stop at the Rocker Ready Check-In Table located at the Devereaux Library** to pick up the student information packet. Below are some of the items that will be in your student's packet.
 - Student Orientation Schedule
 - Campus Map
 - Name Tag

Parking Passes: If your student already registered for a parking pass and will be living on campus, their parking pass will be in their campus mailbox by the Surbeck Center front desk. They will receive their mailbox combination at residence hall check-in. If your student is living off campus, they will need to pick up their parking pass at Facilities Services on the east side of campus (building #25 on the campus map).

- Go to the Student Laptop Pick-up, also in the Devereaux Library, at the time you scheduled.**
(Students will need their Grubby ID credentials on their phone for this.)

- Stop at the Parent/Family Information Table in the Surbeck Center Lobby.** Here you can get questions answered and receive the following:
 - Parent/Family Orientation Schedule & Campus Map
 - Free Tickets for the Farewell Lunch on Friday
 - Black Hills Community Information
 - Sign Up for South Dakota Mines E-newsletters *(if you haven't already done so)*
 - Sample of Student Mailing Address
 - Free Parent Swag

- Stop at the Dining Services Table in the Surbeck Center** for questions about meal plans.

- Stop at the Student Health Services Table in the Surbeck Center** for health-related questions.

- Stop at the Rocker Shop** (near the west entrance of Surbeck Center) to buy/pickup books and to purchase your Hardrocker gear.
