SUBJECT: Dual Use of Credit

NUMBER: Policy II-25-1 (Formerly Policy III-23)

The South Dakota public university system encourages talented high school students to extend their educational background by completing college-level courses while enrolled in high school.

- 1. <u>South Dakota Codified Law 13-28-37</u> provides that students in grades ten, eleven, and twelve may have such courses applied towards Bachelor of Science degree requirements at South Dakota Mines.
- 2. The student shall be enrolled as a special, non-degree-seeking student.
- 3. The student is responsible for all fees, tuition, and costs of attendance not paid for by the school district.
- 4. With the school district's approval, these courses are applied to high school graduation requirements.
- 5. Documentation and additional admission procedures will be required.
