Applicants may apply prior to bachelor's degree completion; in this case, evidence of degree completion must be received prior to enrollment. If you have attended a South Dakota Regental institution (BHSU, DSU, NSU, SDSM&T, SDSU, or USD), you do not need to request your transcript to be sent to us; this will be provided for you.

*Minimum scores require English proficiency testing upon arrival at the university.

**Upper level scores indicate that no additional proficiency test is required by the university. However, additional testing may be required based on the student's performance on other placement exams or in the classroom.

Required application materials for applicants to degree seeking programs:

- **\$35.00 (U.S.) Non-refundable Application Fee.** This is payable online by credit card at the time of application or by check or money order via postal mail. Checks should be made out to: South Dakota School of Mines & Technology. All charges are non-refundable and cannot be waived. The application fee must be received before any action can be taken on the application.
- **Official U.S. Transcripts (if applicable) and Evidence of Bachelor's Degree.** Official transcripts from all U.S. institutions attended, including evidence of your bachelor's degree. Transcripts must be mailed directly to SDSM&T by the issuing institution. Scanned copies are not accepted. A GPA of 3.0 is recommended; students with exceptional ability may apply with less than 3.0 GPA. All transcripts and credentials become property of this institution and will not be returned to the applicant. Applicants may apply prior to bachelor's degree completion; in this case, evidence of degree completion must be received prior to enrollment. If you have attended a South Dakota Regental institution (BHSU, DSU, NSU, SDSM&T, SDSU, or USD), you do not need to request your transcript to be sent to us; this will be provided for you.

Required materials for all international applicants (and U.S. applicants who have attended institutions outside the U.S.):

- **Third party foreign transcript evaluation** for all foreign institutions attended, including evidence of your bachelor's degree. SDSM&T requires a course-by-course evaluation report sent directly to us from the evaluating institution. For more information, visit wes.org or ece.org. Applicants may apply prior to bachelor's degree completion; in this case, evidence of degree completion must be received prior to enrollment.
- **Evidence of English Proficiency.** An international applicant for graduate school must provide evidence of English proficiency, with the exception of applicants from countries where English is the native language. Applicants who have a prior degree from a university in the U.S. may also be considered for exemption. **An official copy of the score report is required to be sent to us directly from the issuing entity.** The SDSM&T school code for TOEFL is 6652. Additional required materials for some programs*:

- **One page statement of purpose/personal statement of goals and research interests:** Please include details such as your areas of special interest, your experience to date which helped prepare you and guided you to consider graduate school, your hopes for your future career, etc. This can be submitted online at the time of application or emailed to us.
- **GRE Score Report: An official copy of the score report is required to be sent directly to us by Educational Testing Services (ETS).** The SDSM&T school code is 6652. Percentile scores of 50% or higher are recommended; strong quantitative scores are expected. For more information regarding the GRE test, visit www.ets.org/gre.

Three Letters of Recommendation: The email addresses of three references who have agreed to provide recommendations shall be submitted at the time of the online application. The references will be sent an email with a link to a form. Recommendations can also be submitted via email or postal mail, but must come directly from the reference. Applicants will be responsible for following up with references to ensure the document is submitted.

*Application document exceptions:

- For current students and graduates of SD Mines, the GRE is waived in all programs except Geology and Geological Engineering (M.S. & Ph.D.), Paleontology (M.S.), and Physics (Ph.D).
- Civil and Environmental Engineering does not require the GRE for applicants to the non-thesis track.
- Computational Sciences and Robotics does not require the GRE score report.
- Construction Engineering and Management does not require the GRE score report.
- Electrical Engineering requires the GRE score report only from graduates from non-ABET accredited institutions.
- Engineering Management does not require the statement of purpose, GRE score report, or letters of recommendation.
- Mining Engineering and Management requires the GRE score report, but it may be waived with significant work experience (letters of recommendation and statement of purpose are required).
- Master of Engineering does not require the GRE score report or letters of recommendation.
