# Kick Ball

#### 1) TEAM SIZE

- a) A co-ed Kickball Ball team consists of nine players, including a catcher. At least four of these players must be female.
- b) A team will be allowed to start a game with as few as seven players, one of which must be a catcher. In Co-Rec play there is a gender difference of one (1) that can be either male or female.

## 2) LENGTH OF GAME

- a) A game will be seven innings or forty minutes in duration.
- b) The ten-run rule will be in effect after the fifth full inning.

## 3) EQUIPMENT

a) Players must wear shoes with non-marking soles.

## 4) RULES OF PLAY

- a) The pitcher must ROLL the ball to the kicking team. The ball may not bounce or it is considered a ball.
- b) Base runners may not leave a base before the ball is kicked. (Any lead off will be ruled an out)
- h) Any ball kicked above the bleachers (avoiding the ceiling) or that hits above the gray painted stripe is a homerun.
- i) A kicked ball that hits any part of the ceiling or anything attached to the ceiling results in an out.
- j) A kicker must kick the ball within five feet of home plate. Violating this rule results in a strike being called. Violating this rule on the third pitch results in an out.
- k) Bunting is allowed.
- l) No sliding.
- M) The kicking line-up must alternate guy, girl, guy, girl, guy, girl.

#### Outs

Each team gets three outs per inning.

A kicker is out when...

- three strikes are thrown
- a ball is kicked foul on the third strike
- when the fielding team touches a base with a ball before the kicker arrives in a force out situation.
- he or she is hit with a thrown ball below the shoulders while running the bases
- a kicked ball is caught by a fielder before hitting the ground
