

FY24 Grad Assistant tuition incentive rates

Stipend rates: Assistantships can be awarded for 15 or 20 hours per week. Students must be paid at least the minimum rate below and be registered for the allowed number of credits (9-10 in fall or spring, 2 in summer) to qualify for an assistantship.

Tuition Remission: Graduate Assistants (TA's and RA's) are eligible for a tuition reduction that covers 100% of tuition and program fees for campus courses. The general activity fee and other miscellaneous fees are assessed at the regular rate.

Compensated hours: Grad assistantship EPAFs can be issued in the following increments:

- full time (.5 FTE),
- 3/4 time (.37 FTE),
- hybrid assistantships (2 positions of .12, .25, or .37 FTE. The total of the positions must equal .37 or .5 FTE.)

During the academic year, ALL grad students are limited to 20 compensated hours per week for all positions combined. Students with a summer assistantship may also be awarded an hourly appointment subject to the conditions listed in this document. (A student with a full time summer assistantship of 20 hours and max hourly pay of 10 hours may be eligible for up to 30 hours per week.)

FICA/Fringe: BOR policy 5:6 states graduate students may be subject to FICA withholding when enrolled in fewer than 5 credits (excluding international students residing in the U.S. less than 5 years). Departments, PI's, and students should anticipate an 8% fringe rate in these cases (usually during the summer term).

FY24 Grad Assistant tuition incentive rates

Registration requirements & student costs: Students must be registered for the allowed number of credits (9 or 10 in fall or spring, 2 in summer) to qualify for an assistantship. Students can qualify for an assistantship with fewer than full time credits in the final semester (1 time only).

Grad assistants are assessed the general activity fee for campus courses. Nonresident students enrolled in distance courses with CEM, ENGM, and MEM prefix are assessed an online delivery fee. Campus international students are also assessed a \$150 fee each fall and spring semester.

Grad hourly requirements do not apply to federal work study or non-academic positions such as Campus Safety, Dining, etc. Hourly positions do not include reduced tuition.
