## MS Program 2-, 3-, 5-, and 6-year Graduation Rates

Note: Graduation rates were tabulated based on the university database for Academic Years (AY) AY2006-07 through AY2009-10, but these reports only counted students matriculating in the Fall, so the cohort sizes are incomplete. Graduate rates for these cohorts are likely representative but not verified.

Beginning in AY2010-11, complete cohorts are tracked using a Graduate Office database. These data are more reliable and provide the most accurate picture of persistence and graduation rates for MS students.

## **MS Program Student Success**

Student outcomes (i.e. the result of study in a program) have been reliably tracked in a Graduate Office database since AY2010-11. Note that recent cohorts naturally have more students in progress and fewer students graduated.

- "In progress" includes students actively working on the degree.
- "Inactive" includes students on an approved Leave of Absence or who are no longer actively pursuing the degree. "Terminated" includes students dropped from the program for academic insufficiency.
- "Transferred" includes students who transferred to a different graduate degree program within SD Mines.
