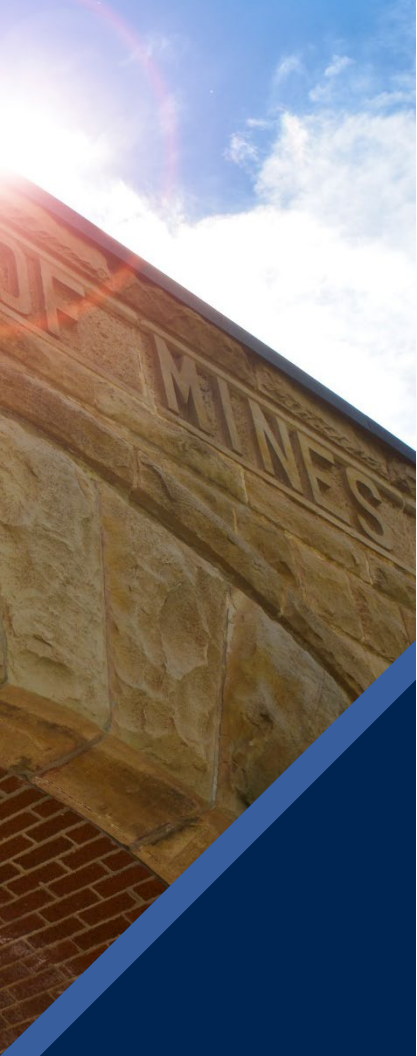




Veterans Advisory Committee

Committee Charter/Purpose:
