South Dakota Mines – Directions to King Center & Campus Parking

No parking passes needed the day of the career fair day nor the day after.

The Career Fair will be held in the King Center with parking spots available near the main entrance by the parking lot. We suggest you arrive early and drop off your materials at the parking lot entrance. We will have students helping with directions and bringing in your display materials.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

***From the East** – From I-90 take Exit 57; continue south to St. Joseph Street. Turn left and continue driving about 1.5 miles. Turn right at Hardrocker Entrance (Birch Avenue) continue following as it veers left and turns into University Loop. Stay on University Loop until you reach the parking lot behind the King Center/Newlin Wellness Center.

***From the West** – From I-90 take Exit 57; continue south to St. Joseph Street. Turn left and continue driving about 1.5 miles. Turn right at Hardrocker Entrance (Birch Avenue) continue following as it veers left and turns into University Loop. Stay on University Loop until you reach the parking lot behind the King Center/Newlin Wellness Center.

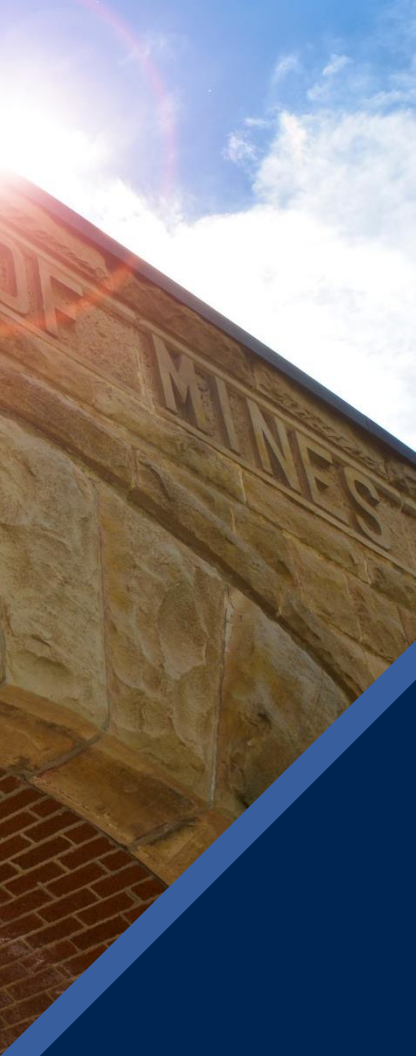
***Highway 16 (from the South)** – Drive to St. Joseph Street (1.5 miles) and turn right. Continue driving about 1.3 miles. Turn right at Hardrocker Entrance (Birch Avenue) continue following as it veers left and turns into University Loop. Stay on University Loop until you reach the parking lot behind the King Center/Newlin Wellness Center.

***From the Airport** – Turn right onto SD-44. Drive 5.7 miles to St. Patrick Street and turn left. Drive 1.4 miles to St. Joseph Street and turn right. Go 1/2 mile and turn left at Gold Entrance (University Loop) continue following University Loop, it will veer right and take you to the parking lot behind the King Center/Newlin Wellness Center.

***Highway 79 (from the South)** – Drive to St. Patrick Street (first light after overpass). Turn left and drive about 2 blocks; turn right at the stop light onto St. Joseph Street. Go 1/2 mile and turn left at Gold Entrance (University Loop) continue following University Loop, it will veer right and take you to the parking lot behind the King Center/Newlin Wellness Center.

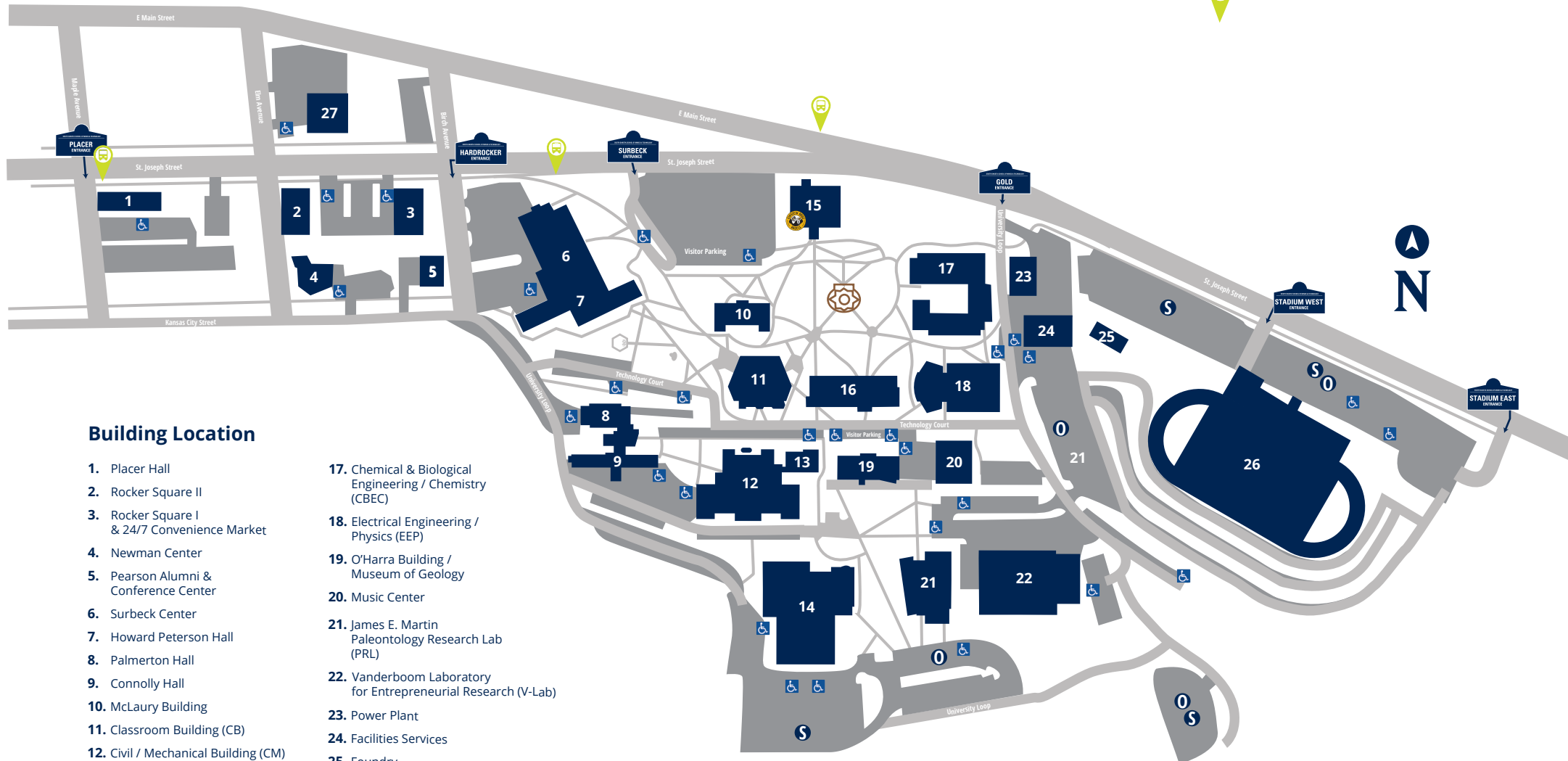
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Map Key
