

Student Health Services New Student Check list:

Regional Health Urgent Care provides Student health services to all actively enrolled students, regardless of health insurance coverage.

- Complete the following forms:
 - Student Health Registration
 - Consent for Treatment
 - Health History

- Verify Insurance Benefits:
 - Call your Insurance Company and verify coverage
 - Obtain additional Copy of Insurance Card for your student to carry
 - If no coverage may contact:
 - The South Dakota HealthCare Marketplace at <https://www.healthcare.gov> or call 800-318-2596

- Prescription Medications
 - Bring a copy of your current medication list
 - Bring enough of your ongoing medication for the first month of school, and bring a copy of the prescription with you.
 - Plan ahead for refills.

- First Aid Kit – Bring a First aid kit for the dorm room that includes:
 - Bandages and Antibiotic ointment
 - Cold Relief medications cough drops, nasal spray
 - Digital Thermometer
 - Hand Sanitizer
 - Over the counter pain reliever

- Chronic Health Problems
 - Bring a summary of your health problems such as asthma or diabetes from your health care provider. This helps the Student Health staff provide you with the best possible care.
